# **The Earle Williams and Larry Austin Educational Scholarship**

- Purpose:** To honor the memory and contributions of Earle Williams and Larry Austin to “Creative Problem Solving” and the East Texas DI Region
- Amount:** \$500 each
- Deadline:** All applications must be postmarked by February 12, 2019. Late applications will not be reviewed.
- Eligibility:** A graduating senior from the East Texas Region who has participated in Destination Imagination in the past or currently participates in Destination Imagination. Current year participation is not required in order to be eligible for the award.
- Criteria:** Student must:
- 1) Submit the completed application form by the deadline listed above.
  - 2) Include a high school transcript containing grades for first semester of the current year. Attach a list of current spring semester courses being taken.
  - 3) Include two letters of recommendation. (See Part IV, A & B)
  - 4) Include an essay. (See Part IV, C.)
- Judging:** A committee formed by current East Texas Region board members will read and rank all applications submitted. The decision of the committee is final.
- Award:** The educational scholarship will be awarded at the East Texas Destination Imagination Regional Competition Awards Ceremony, Saturday, February 23, 2019, Poteet High School, Mesquite, Texas. Attendance at the awards ceremony is not required.
- Payment:** The scholarship will be paid to the recipient upon verification of registration at a college or university after high school graduation. The recipient is responsible for submitting the documentation to the East Texas Regional Treasurer.
